

CAMPGROUND RULES

1. **The speed limit anywhere inside the campground is 10 km/h.** This rule is strictly enforced and anyone violating this rule will be asked to leave without refund. Please follow the internal traffic rules and keep your vehicle on gravel roads. ATV's and motorcross bikes are not allowed inside the campground.
2. **Quiet hours are between 23h00 and 9h00 hours.** Any camper in violation of this rule will lose their camping privileges and will be evicted without refund.
3. **One camping unit (meaning trailer, RV, camper or sleeping tent) and one vehicle per campsite is allowed.** Please roll up your carpet or floor mats when not in use. Clotheslines or tarp sheds are not allowed.
4. **Campfires are permitted in the designated fire pits only.** It is prohibited to move any of the fire pits. Please keep your flame under control at all times and put out the fire before going to bed. The burning of leaves, cardboard, garbage, metal cans, bottles (glass & plastic) or any toxic material is prohibited. Firewood is available for sale at the office. Cutting any of our trees or branches is vandalism and violators will face immediate eviction and will face legal prosecution.
5. **Place all wet garbage in bags before depositing it into the designated campground garbage bins.** Do not deposit garbage in the fire pits. Recyclable materials (bottles & metal containers) must be separated from the wet garbage and placed in the recyclable materials bin.
6. **Anyone under the age of 19 cannot book a campsite without the presence of their parents and/or legal guardians.** Parents and/or legal guardians are responsible for the conduct of their children. Children under the age of 14 cannot be left unattended inside the campground.
7. **Consumption of alcoholic beverages must be confined to your campsite.** Alcohol is not permitted inside any of the washrooms or any other campground building.
8. **It is prohibited to wash or clean dishes inside the campground washrooms.** Please use the outdoor sink area to wash or clean dishes.
9. **The use of fireworks inside the campground is strictly prohibited.**
10. **Visitors must register with the campground office and must park their vehicle at the public parking area. Visiting hours end at 22h00.**
11. **There is no parking allowed in designated green spaces or in vacant lots. Violators face having their vehicle towed at their expense.**
12. **Pets must be kept on a leash at all times. Please pick up after your pet and do not leave them unattended outside your trailer.**
13. **The campground office and store is open from 8:00 a.m. to 10:00 p.m. daily.** The gate at Wikiwak Lane will close at 23h00. To access the gate at Cedar Lane, a car pass is required. Car passes are available at the campground office upon receipt of a deposit.

14. **Each Full-Service site** is equipped with an electrical (20, 30 or 50 amps), communication (cable TV) and potable water outlet. Sewer outlets are also provided. Campers must use their own outlets and are prohibited from using adjacent outlets, even if they are being unused or if the adjacent campsite is vacant.
15. **Wireless Internet (WIFI) is available throughout the campground.** Registered campers will be given a password to log onto the network. Internet satellite dishes are prohibited inside the campground as they will interfere with the WIFI signal.
16. **Access to bike trail.** Parlee Beach, Pointe du Chene and downtown Shediac are all accessible biking destinations if you utilize the bike trail situated to the north of the campground. The bike trail is accessible from the campground by using the private access trail situated in the north-west corner of the campground or by going out the main gate and turning to the north on South Cove Road. The private access trail is for bicycle and pedestrian use only and will be closed at 22h00. Bicycle operators must abide by our speed limit rule (**10 km/h**) and they must keep their bicycles on the gravel roads inside the campground. It is prohibited to operate a bicycle on designated green spaces or on our golf course. Children under the age of 14 must wear protective headgear and are prohibited from operating their bicycles after dusk.
17. **Please leave the campsite the way you found it.** Campers causing damage to campground property (this includes picnic tables, fire pits, trees and turf grass) will be responsible for such damage. Do not leave your campsite strewn with litter or garbage when checking out. **Check out time is 11:00 a.m.** If you wish to renew your campsite, please do so before 10:00 a.m.
18. **Please secure all personal property on your campsite.** South Cove (Rive-sud) Camping & Golf will not be held liable for any damage or for any claim brought by a camper or a visitor by reason of an accident, a theft, or any other loss.
