

# Camping rules

Help us make the Camping experience enjoyable for everyone!

Please respect these rules.

#### Circulation in the park and parking of vehicles

- Maximum 1 car per lot.
- Maximum speed of 10 km/h.
- The only vehicles authorized to circulate on the campsite are those belonging to the campers staying there.
- Campers with more than one vehicle must use the parking lot at the reception office.
- Campers must follow the road signs present on the campsite.
- No vehicle may be parked on the lawn, along the traffic lane and in an unoccupied space.
- We encourage you to walk around the grounds and use the walking trails near the campground to get to your activities in the community.

#### **Visitors**

All visitors must go to the reception to register. They must park their car in the parking lot at the reception desk.

# Pet policy

Dogs are allowed at the campsite. They must be always kept on a leash and under supervision. One must immediately pick up all their waste and put it in an appropriate bin. Bags provided for this purpose are available at the reception desk

#### **Curfew - Noise**



Campers come to live a peaceful and pleasant experience. We ask you to respect other campers: curfew between 11 p.m. and 8 a.m.

- Campers must avoid any noise and excessive discussion that could disturb other campers.
- Sound devices must be adjusted in such a way as to respect other campers.

#### **Consumption**

- Consumption of alcoholic beverages must be limited to your campsite.
- The use of cannabis is strictly restricted inside your trailer.

#### **Campfires**

Except during prohibition periods, fires are permitted at the campsite in the fireplaces provided for this purpose. It is strictly forbidden to cut trees or burn your waste.

Note: The fire index is displayed at the reception desk every day, please refer to it before lighting a fire.

#### **Respect for facilities**

- All campers must refrain from any action that could harm the cleanliness, hygiene and appearance of the campsite: each site must be kept clean and tidy.
- Clotheslines are not permitted. (Umbrella or portable models are accepted).
- Each camper is required to pay particular attention to the cleanliness of sanitary facilities and showers. Any malfunction must be immediately reported to the office reception.
- Waste must be disposed of in the places provided for this purpose. Be sure to keep garbage bags tightly closed. The big garbage cans are near the exit of the campsite.
- Do not put your waste in the fire pits.
- An outdoor sink is available for washing dishes. It is forbidden to use sinks in washrooms.



## **Security**

- Campers must take the necessary precautions to safeguard their equipment.
- The management and the campsite will not be responsible for any theft, vandalism or breakage occurring on the campsite.
- Children should always be under the supervision of their parents.
- The use of fireworks is strictly prohibited.

### **Non-compliance with regulations**

- Management reserves the right to evict any disruptive camper without refund.
- Additional fees may apply to compensate for damage to the campground.
